

WARM UP PROCEDURES AND POLICIES

- Please display correct exhibitor numbers at all times when working horses. An extra number has been provided to use for warm up to help maintain your exhibitor numbers in show condition.
- Please check in at the paddock in Barn 1 at any time during the day you are to show.
- Warm up scheduling may be altered by changes in projected start and finish times and ground maintenance. Listen for announcements or ask the paddock managers.
- Be familiar with the warm up schedule to help plan the times that best suit your schooling needs.
- Scratched entries are not allowed in the coliseum.
- Assist the person monitoring the paddock by complying with instructions and requests.
- Be concerned with everyone's safety in the pen.
- Circling during structured formats will be in accordance with the pattern designations. The upper end of the pen away from the gate will circle in a clockwise direction to the right. The lower end of the pen will circle in a counterclockwise direction to the left.
- When circling, a rider may stop in the middle for a brief time to settle his/her horse, but then must retire to the ends or sides of the pen for further rest. Any time the monitor feels that the horses in the middle of the pen has become a problem, the paddock monitor will ask riders to move those horses from the middle.
- Fencers must yield to all traffic.
- Before backing or rollbacks, please be aware of the proximity of the riders behind you.
- Any horse may warm up during non-restricted times. The times set for Futurity horses only is intended to help exhibitors with similar preparation needs a time to prepare. Other times in the arena may be used for preparation by Futurity horses or any horses entered in the show.
- Horses not entered in the show, but offered for sale and being demonstrated to potential buyers, are restricted solely to Barns 3, 7 and 9 during the day and Barns 3, 6, 7 or 9 during non-show hours.
- No cell phones are to be used while riding in any of the arenas.
