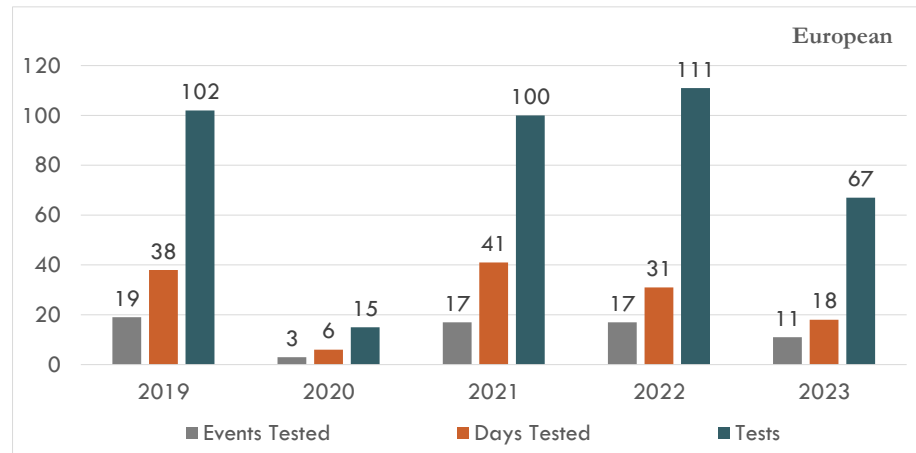
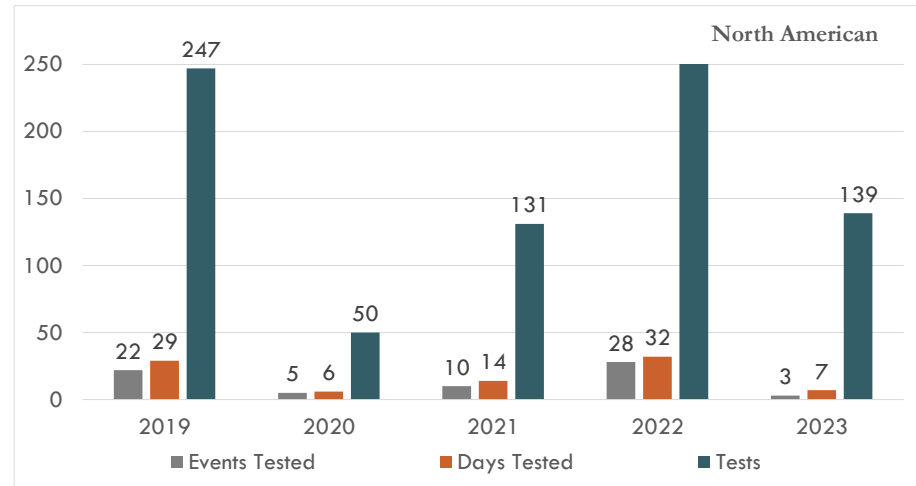

Examples of Substances

Controlled - Overage of an allowed NSAID such as phenylbutazone (Bute®) or flunixin meglumine (Banamine®), cetirizine, guaifenesin, etc.

Forbidden - clenbuterol, chlorpromazine, cannabidiols, fluphenazine, fluoxetine, guanabenz acetate, lidocaine, reserpine, xylazine, etc.



Medications Testing Budget

North American testing is funded by a \$10/event/horse fee (exception AA and ARC events who have a \$35/event/horse fee). These funds go into a budget for testing. Based on this income, the number of testing events and tests performed is determined to utilize these funds.

European testing is funded with a 35€ /event/horse fee for events with \$15,000 or more added in Europe. It is recommended, for every 20 horses that 1 horse be tested.
